

Odd or Even?



Materials: counters of 1 colour, recording sheet, 2 sheets of paper

- ▣ Players decide who will be odd and who will be even.
- ▣ Each player hides some counters (up to 20) under their sheet of paper.
- ▣ When they are ready, both players show their counters, put the 2 sets together, and match all the counters in pairs.
- ▣ If the end result is odd (1 left over), the player who is odd gets 1 point. If the end result is even (none left over), the player who is even gets 1 point.
- ▣ The first player to score 10 points wins.
